

APPOINTMENT OF ARBITRATOR

The initial Agreement to Arbitrate, or submission, is usually the Arbitration Clause in an existing contract. If, however, there is no submission or the reference is to be wider or more particular than the submission allows, the parties may enter into a separate written Agreement such as the following or a variation of the following.

2. The parties appoint **ANTHONY W FINNIGAN** of Palmerston North, as Arbitrator.

3. The parties agree to abide by the current Arbitration Protocol of the Arbitrators' and Mediators' Institute of New Zealand Inc.
